I haven't seen him this animated for a long time, and I was also able to relax and chat to other carers and families there. It really made a real difference to us both."*

Bringing people together - dementia wellbeing activities

Meaningful activities at the Hub have expanded and developed. With your support this year we have supported over 1,000 people living with dementia, their family, friends and carers.

We continue our programme of activities such as singing, Variety Hour and social afternoons, and we have also added more art sessions and physical wellbeing activities.

Racing to the target of £1.74 million – it is a matter of months before we officially open, and we are racing to raise the final £200,000. With the renovations happening and Dementia Support helping more families each week, it is vital we succeed!

Together with your help we are already reducing the isolation and loneliness felt by people living with dementia, we are improving access to information and advice and increasing opportunities to improve wellbeing.
